The Mull & Iona Community Trust has assisted in securing funds to:

- provide every household on the islands with a free home computer
- enable the Mull Fishermen's Association to upgrade the Fishermen's Pier in Tobermory
- carry out an island wide survey, *Island Voices*, to determine future development plans
- complete the construction of a swimming pool on Mull
- enable Dervaig Community Hall to install an all weather sports pitch
- install a new public footpath from Tobermory to Aros Park after the original was destroyed in landslide. Also secured funds to provide children's play equipment through-out the Park
- install a coastal public footpath from Craignure to Java
- complete a feasibility study into establishing a Biogas Plant on Mull
- secure a 'Rocket Composter' for the island which turns organic waste into compost
- employ a Training and Development Officer for the Argyll & Bute Social Enterprise Network
- build the Ross of Mull Historical Centre, now a registered charity and successful community group
- create the Mull & Iona wildlife Heritage Trail, providing 10 public viewpoints with car parking and an interpretational heritage map of the islands
- allow the Mull District Fisheries Board to conduct a survey of juvenile stocks of migratory fish in all Mull's major rivers
