The request will be considered by an independent CATS Evaluation Panel, appointed by Forest Enterprise Scotland. The decision whether to agree to the Asset Transfer will be made by the Chief Executive of Forest Enterprise Scotland, taking into account the assessment of the Request by the CATS Evaluation Panel, and the input of relevant Forest Enterprise Scotland officers. We will give you notice of our decision whether to agree to or refuse your request, and our reasons for that decision, by 3 October 2018.

If you do not receive a decision by that date, you may appeal to the Scottish Ministers. You may also appeal if your request is refused, or if the request is agreed but the decision notice specifies material terms or conditions which differ to a significant extent from those specified in the request.
